**Notice of Proposed Amendment to Local Court Rule

In accordance with Trial Rule 81 of the Indiana Court Rules, the Jefferson Circuit and Superior Courts hereby give notice to the bar and the public that the Courts propose to amend the Local Rule LR39-AR00-1, Ban on Weapons; Exceptions, for the courts of record of Jefferson County, effective July 1, 2022.

All new text is shown by underlining and deleted text is shown by ~~strike through~~. Supreme Court approval is required for certain Local Rules and may not take effect until approved by the Supreme Court.

Notice has been given to the public by posting on the website of the Jefferson County Clerk and at the Indiana Judiciary webpage for Local Rules (<https://www.in.gov/courts/publications/local-rules/>), and by furnishing a copy to the officers of the Jefferson County Bar Association. A paper copy of the proposed amended local rule will be made available for viewing in the office of the Clerk of Jefferson County, 300 E. Main Street, Room 203, Madison, Indiana 47250, during normal business hours.

The time period for the bar and the public to comment shall begin on May 1, 2022, and shall close on May 31, 2022. The proposed amendments to the rule will be adopted, modified or rejected before June 1, 2022, and, if required, the final version of the rule will be submitted to the Indiana Supreme Court for review and approval not later than June 30, 2022.
